ITINERARY

23 JUL (SUN)

MÜCKE, GERMANY – ROTHENBURG

- Travel the famed Romantic Road from Frankfurt to Rothenburg ob der Tauber.
- Rothenburg Orientation guided walk. Get that old romantic feeling with a walk through the well-preserved medieval town of Rothenburg. Here, along Germany's historic Romantic Road region, you'll find half-timbered houses, medieval walls, and cobblestone streets that will win your heart in the heart of Northern Bayaria.

24 JUL (MON)

ROTHENBURG – LAKE CHIEMSEE – SALZBURG

- After breakfast continue down the Romantic Road to Lake Chiemsee.
- Enjoy a guided tour of the town and lake at Lake Chiemsee before heading to Salzburg.

Day 3 – 25 JUL (TUE) **SALZBURG**

 Circled by hills positively pulsating with the sound of music. This wonderful half-day excursion gives you an in-depth look at both Salzburg and its majestic surroundings as you follow in the footsteps of "The Sound of Music's" Maria von Trapp. Led by an expert guide, see Mirabell Gardens, where Maria and the children sang "Do-Re-Mi" and Nonnberg Abbey, where Maria was late to Mass. Also visit Leopoldskron Castle, where Maria and the children were boating and fell in the water; the stunning Lake District to see the "Sixteen Going on Seventeen" gazebo; the lake near St. Gilgen, featured in the stunning scenery shots at the beginning of the movie; and, of course, Mondsee Cathedral, site of Maria and Captain von Trapp's memorable wedding scene.

Day 4 - 26 JUL (WED)

SALZBURG – NEUSCHWANSTEIN CASTLE -- FUSSEN

Scenic drive this morning to Neuschwanstein Castle

· Guided tour of Neuschwanstein Castle. King Ludwig II of Bavaria, the "Fairy tale King," built a fantastical 1800s castle with all the modern conveniences (aka plumbing), while emphasizing the romantic vision of a storybook castle. His love for Wagnerian opera is literally plastered on the walls inside, with panoramas and frescoes of scenes from the composer's great works. So romantic and fanciful of design, the Neuschwanstein Castle inspired Walt Disney's blueprint of a castle fit for Sleeping Beauty herself.

FUSSEN. EXCURSION TO ZUGSPITZE

After breakfast, depart for a full day at Germany's highest point ZugSpitze. Enjoy the cable car ride. Two fully glazed high-capacity cabins transport up to 580 passengers per hour to the peak, banishing queues to history. Along the journey, they traverse the world's highest steelwork pylon for aerial tramways at 127 metres, the world's greatest overall height difference of 1,945 metres over one section as well as the world's longest unsupported span, measuring 3,213 metres. Three incredible records - without even mentioning the magnificent panoramic views offered by the spacious cabins with floor-to-ceiling glazing. Thanks to heated windows, unobstructed visibility can also be enjoyed in bad weather. Views extend even as far as Munich on clear days.



Day 6 - 28 JUL (FRI) FUSSEN - BLACK FOREST - HEIDELBERG

- Begin the day with a photo stop at Rhine Falls. Then on to enjoy highlights of the Black Forest including at a traditional woodcarving demonstration followed by Kaffee und Schwarzwaldkuchen (coffee and Black Forest Cake).
- Continue on to Heidelberg for overnight.
- A special dinner at Kulturbrauerei Heidelberg restaurant. Lift a glass of German beer in Kulturbrauerei Heidelberg brauhaus. Enjoy the famous tastes of Germany in this elegant and rustic beer house where hospitality is served in the heart of the brewery, along with legendary beers – both traditional and modern.



Day 7 – 29 JUL (SAT) **HEIDLEBERG – FRANKFURT**

- Morning orientation walk through Old Town Heidleberg. Ascend 300 feet above Heidelberg to visit its historic castle, posing a commanding presence above the town below. The breathtaking Schloss Heidelberg features buildings and courtyards reflecting unique architectural eras, as well as the biggest wine barrel in the world! Just as the city below delivers a powerful view of the castle, you'll take in the panoramic views of Heidelberg below the terraces and gardens of the hilltop fortress. Cast your eyes across the Neckar River and valley, with views as far as the Rhine plain and Mannheim on a clear day.
- Scenic drive to Frankfurt and farewell dinner at local restaurant

Day 8 - 30 JUL (SUN) **DEPART FRANKFURT, GERMANY**

 After breakfast, one group transfer to the Frankfurt Airport.
